PUBLIC NOTICE**

IN THE MATTER OF THE COMPANIES ACT CH 81:01

**AND IN THE MATTER OF PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO
DELIVER AND FILE POST INCORPORATION DOCUMENTS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to **ALL** companies regulated under the Companies Act ("the Act"), including external companies, that post incorporation documents must be delivered to or filed with the Registrar of Companies within the time limits specified under the Act to avoid the payment of prescribed penalties.

AND NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that section 516 of the Act provides that:

"where, contrary to a provision of this Act a person or company, including an external company, fails, within the time specified for so doing, to deliver or file with the Registrar any document, the Registrar shall be entitled to collect from that person or company a penalty of one hundred dollars for every month or part thereof, that that person or company fails to deliver or to file the document".

AND NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that failure to deliver or file any document within the time specified for so doing constitutes a contravention of the Act.

AND NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the statutory penalties for such contraventions will be imposed from **NOVEMBER 2ND, 2009**.

COMPANIES ARE THEREFORE ADVISED THAT THEY SHOULD COMPLY WITH THE DELIVERY AND FILING REQUIREMENTS OF THE ACT TO AVOID THE IMPOSITION OF SUCH PENALTIES.
